The senior year brings with it many new experiences, new opportunities and new responsibilities. One such new experience has traditionally been to take senior photographs, which helps to create memories of seniors' last year in high school and at EHS. Senior photographs, different than regular yearbook photographs students take at EHS on senior photo days, can also tell a "story" through props, uniforms, and more formal attire. In other words, senior photographs give seniors an opportunity to feel unique.

Seniors who are interested in senior photographs will have the opportunity to work with locally-owned Kirkwood Photo, the official photography company for EHS and the class of 2024. The relationship between Kirkwood Photo and EHS is an important one that allows for flexibility and convenience in scheduling appointments for Senior Photo Sessions. In addition, Kirkwood Photo supports EHS and gives back to the yearbook program. Purchasing senior picture packages from Kirkwood Photo helps to support our yearbook program.

Please note these important tips regarding senior pictures:

- To appear in the senior section of the book, seniors must be photographed by Kirkwood Photo. If seniors choose to go with one of the Senior Photo Sessions that Kirkwood Photo is offering, they will take the yearbook photo at that appointment. Enclosed you will find information about the session package options. Please call Kirkwood Photo at 812-332-4888 to schedule a Senior Photo Session. Sessions will be available between May 30th to July 28th.
- If seniors only want a yearbook photo, then they need to have their photo taken at KPL this summer. Senior Yearbook Photo Days are scheduled for Wednesday, July 26th and Thursday, July 27th. Kirkwood Photo will be in the studio from 10-5. Please come dressed appropriately for your yearbook dress code. You will have an opportunity to approve this photo immediately after it is taken.
- **Dress code:** Our goal for the senior section is for students to dress in an outfit that is authentic and comfortable, yet professional and dignified. We strive for the senior class to present a unified group impression. To be photographed for and appear in the yearbook senior section, students should follow these guidelines:

Do:

Dress as if preparing for a professional interview.

Choose a dress, dressy sweater, blouse, top, or shirt. If appropriate for you, consider a tie and/or a jacket/blazer.

Don't:

Wear shirts/tops with straps, spaghetti straps or no straps that might seem to completely disappear when the photo is cropped for the yearbook.

Wear clothing that is inappropriately revealing in any way.

Wear clothing featuring words, logos, or other strong graphic elements that will look distracting in the final image.

Please use your good judgment to appear neat and professional in your senior yearbook photo.

• To maintain a professional presentation, The EHS Yearbook requires consistency in the head size, background and pose; therefore, only portraits taken by Kirkwood Photo will be included in the book.
